Class Descriptions

Puppy Class

Designed for puppies 6 months or younger. Start your puppy off on the right paw by introducing them to training at an early age. By starting obedience training early, you can begin to establish good behavior and introduce skills to your pup that will help make them a well trained adult dog. We will teach them that training is fun! This class will introduce you and your pup to simple behaviors such as sit, down, come and how to use a kennel.

Average Number of Classes: 3

Beginner Class

Designed for dogs 6 months or older that have minimal or no prior training experience. This class is a must have for dogs of all ages and will cover basic obedience behaviors such as sit, down, come, and stay. Already know some of these behaviors? No problem! All Floofins and Co. classes are customized to meet the needs of each owner. This class will teach you how to train your dog so that both of your lives are more fulfilling and less stressful. It is the beginning to having a well mannered dog!

Advanced Class

Interested in more training? This class is designed for dogs 1 year or older that have completed a beginner level obedience class through Floofins and Co. (or equivalent) and owners that have an understanding of the basics in positive reinforcement training. Build your training skills by learning to work further from your dog and work around distractions.

- _____ **Treat Pouch.** (Keeps the treats out of reach until they are needed. Alternative: wear a sweatshirt or pants with pockets)
- _____ **Leash.** (Just in case we want or need to work on leash)
- _____ **Clicker.** (Used to mark good behaviors. Optional)
- _____ **Space.** (Have room to work with limited distractions)
- _____ **A Hungry Pooch.** (Don't feed your dog right before class. Most dogs will work for their food and we can use that as rewards for some of the training!)
